A SERIAL ARSON MYSTERY NOVEL

Did You Ever Wonder What Goes Through the Mind of a Serial Arsonist? Did You Ever Wonder How Wildland Arson Investigators Find the Point of Origin of a Fire That Burns Over Thousands of Acres? Read ***RED FLAG WARNING***.

Malibu, CA. June 2010 - Los Angeles County is burning. A serial arsonist is setting the parched hills on fire. Plunge into infernos and face the smoke, heat and danger with the men on the fire lines. While NiteHeat prowls in the darkness, setting fires and taunting investigators, the Los Angeles County Fire Department's Arson Unit struggles to find the fire-setter and stop the devastation.

Malibu resident Kurt Kamm today announced publication by Aberdeen Bay of ***RED FLAG WARNING***, a serial arson mystery set in Southern California. Across the nation, wildland fires started by arsonists are killing people, destroying property and ravaging the environment. In 2009, the Station Fire, the largest in Los Angeles County history, burned 155,000 acres and killed two firefighters. The arsonist has not been found. Recently, an arsonist was sentenced to death for the Esperanza wildland fire in Riverside County, which killed five firefighters.

During the two years spent writing this compelling mystery novel, Mr. Kamm attended the CalFire Wildland Arson Investigation Academy, joined investigators from the Los Angeles County Fire Department's Arson Investigation Unit, and met with an arson profiler at the ATF and other law enforcement officers.

RED FLAG WARNING was awarded second place in the Pasco Regional Writers (Infinite Writer) 2010 Fiction Contest in the Mystery Category. Kurt Kamm's first novel, ***ONE FOOT IN THE BLACK***, is a coming of age novel about a wildland firefighter. ***RED FLAG WARNING*** and ***ONE FOOT IN THE BLACK*** are available on Amazon, through bookstores or his fire website.
